



**Graduation Day, May 23, 2020, will be a little different this year!
But that doesn't mean it doesn't have to happen.**

West Las Vegas Schools remains committed to celebrating the accomplishments, success and resiliency of the Class of 2020. Therefore, graduation day will still be on May 23, 2020. This is the day you have worked towards for years and we want you to still have something so that day remains special to you and your family.

A drive through ceremony will be held on May 23, 2020, beginning at 10:00 AM. In order to partake in this ceremony, there are guidelines that must be followed. (Participation is completely optional.)

1. Seniors will need to pick up a place card at the High School office as follows by last name:

A-D	8:00 – 11:00 AM	THURSDAY, May 21, 2020
E-L	12:30 – 3:30 PM	THURSDAY, May 21, 2020
M-Z*	8:00 – 11:00 AM	FRIDAY, May 21, 2020

* any AP student who may have missed their scheduled time due to AP testing

2. On Saturday morning, graduates will need to be in their cap and gown and be seated in the front passenger seat of a vehicle. Only **ONE enclosed vehicle** per graduate will be allowed on campus and must have a place card displayed in their windshield in order to even enter campus. Nobody will be allowed to exit their vehicles in any area of campus. There may not be anyone riding in the back of trucks or open vehicles. Graduates will need to be at WLVS student parking by 9:15 AM.
3. Staff will direct traffic as per the attached map.

5. Please decorate your vehicle in an appropriate manner to honor your grad including the yard signs in the Plaza Park.

Anyone who does not comply with the NMPED 2020 High School Graduation Guidance Memo and Governor Grisham's orders will be escorted away by law enforcement. If anyone fails to abide by the requirements the ceremony could be subjected to being discontinued.
